Please note: Faxed or late applications will not be accepted.

The Faculty of Science Dean's Undergraduate Exchange Scholarships are offered to undergraduate students enrolled in a Faculty of Science award course and intending to study overseas through the University of Sydney Exchange program. Before completing this form, please check your eligibility to apply by reading the Conditions of Award listed below. **This Scholarship will be offered for the July Semester 2010.**

The application deadline for the Exchange Program for July Semester 2010 is Friday 30 October 2009. Please submit your application for the Exchange Program to the International Office by this date.

Conditions of Award

The scholarship shall be awarded in 2010 under the following conditions:

1. The scholarship shall be awarded to an undergraduate student currently studying in an award course within the Faculty of Science who has a Weighted Average Mark (WAM) of 75 or higher.
2. The scholarship shall be awarded on the basis of academic merit, based on the student's WAM in the first instance and then on the student's SCIWAM. In addition, the scholarship will be awarded on the basis of the relevance of the proposed exchange studies to the completion of an undergraduate degree from the Faculty of Science and the student's performance at interview.
3. To be eligible for the scholarship, an applicant shall have been successfully selected by the University of Sydney for a student exchange of one or two semesters duration at one of the following ten institutions:
 - University of Hong Kong, Hong Kong
 - Cornell University, Ithaca, New York State, USA
 - University of North Carolina - Chapel Hill, Chapel Hill, North Carolina, USA
 - University of Oslo, Oslo, Norway
 - University of Maastricht, Maastricht, The Netherlands
 - University of California (all campuses), California, USA
 - McGill University, Quebec, Canada
 - Uppsala University, Uppsala, Sweden
 - Lund University, Lund, Sweden
 - University of Glasgow, Glasgow, Scotland, UK

Award of the scholarship shall be conditional until acceptance of the applicant by the exchange university is confirmed.

4. The scholarship will provide a grant of \$5,000 to assist with travel expenses for one semester abroad. There will be up to four scholarships offered for the **July Semester 2010**.
5. The Faculty will consider students who intend to go on exchange for one year, however, the grant will remain \$5,000.
6. The scholarship is offered for, and is tenable in, a specific Science degree or Combined Science degree program and is **not transferable** to another degree program. The degree programs considered include:

7. Scholarship recipients must enrol full-time and meet the conditions of their degree program and exchange arrangement during the tenure of their scholarship. Requests to suspend the scholarship after commencement will only be approved under exceptional circumstances such as a severe medical condition that limits the student's capacity to undertake full-time study. Such requests must be supported by the Dean of the Faculty of Science.
8. Scholarship recipients must **undertake a minimum of 50% of the overall study load** at the overseas institution in **science** areas of study.
9. The scholarship will be terminated if the recipient accepts another scholarship of equal or higher value from the University of Sydney or withdraws from their agreed degree program. Once terminated, a scholarship will not be reinstated.
10. Scholarship funds will be available to successful students after final selection and interviews have taken place. Interviews are expected to occur in April 2010.
11. The Scholarship must be repaid in full if the student is unable to complete their Exchange semester as specified by these guidelines.
